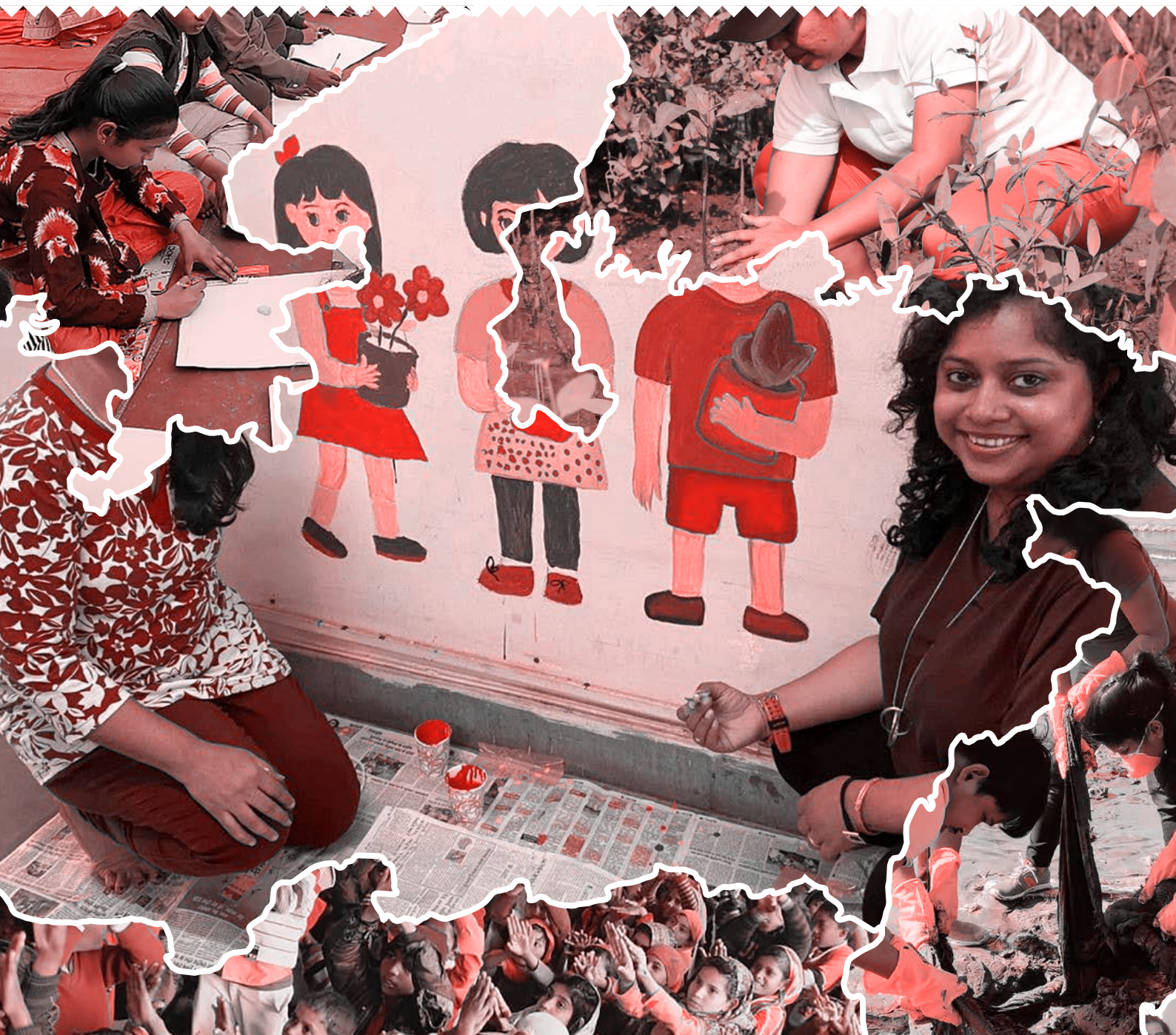

Overview

India@75 is an industry-led people's movement working to build a morally, economically and technologically advanced nation. It is rooted in the vision of the Late Professor CK Prahalad and housed in the CII-supported India@75 Foundation.

Professor CK Prahalad was a man known for both, his remarkable intellect and his deep commitment to poverty alleviation. In 2007, he drew up a development blueprint to catalyze India's journey to world leadership on the strength of its moral leadership, economic power and technological vitality. The blueprint involved achieving well-defined milestones in critical areas by the 75th year of its Independence. He recommended strategies to reach these milestones; one such strategy was participative development leveraging the potential of our youthful demography.

Volunteerism, being a key enabler for participative development, is a strategic area for India@75 Foundation. It works to catalyze a volunteering ecosystem that enables different stakeholders to collaboratively address critical issues facing the country. Working on creating an environment instead of an initiative, ensures scale and importantly builds the culture of volunteerism in the country by promoting the concept of Individual Social Responsibility (ISR).

National Volunteering Week (NVW) is a tool that the Foundation deploys to build a volunteering ecosystem in India. It was instituted in 2014 and has grown in scale since then. It works in tandem with the National Volunteering Grid (NVG) - an online collaboration portal that brings together non-profits, individuals and corporates.

The seventh edition of NVW in January 2020 saw corporates, non-profits, academic institutions, volunteer groups and individuals contribute their skill and time for nation-building. This year's theme continued to be 'I for India' and focused on building a clean and healthy environment.

350 plus activities were organized by non-profits and corporates in about 56 cities across 23 states. People from all walks of life participated in these activities.

At the global level, World Bank has identified active citizenship as an important activity for today's youth. NVW is a platform that engages, unites and channelizes young minds in India towards nation building. Volunteering is helping transform Indian youth into an effective change agent. The number of youths who participate as volunteers during the National Volunteering Week, is indicative of the fact that Young India wants to contribute to societal growth; all they need is opportunity to engage and direction.

In the years to come India@75 aims to further strengthen the volunteering ecosystem in the country, making it the preferred way to contribute to society and the country. If a few thousands can make significant social impact, collated impact of a billion plus Indians is the stuff of dreams. It is a dream that the Foundation is actively pursuing.

Journey thus far

India@75 Foundation organized the seventh National Volunteering Week (NVW) from January 18 to January 24, 2020. NVW gives both individuals and corporates the opportunity to volunteer their time and resources towards building a stronger nation. It also works to strengthen the structured volunteering ecosystem that India@75 has catalyzed in the form of the National Volunteering Grid. This online portal is a convergence platform that connects NGOs to people and organizations who are keen to engage with issues facing the country.

The first chapter of the National Volunteering Week, held in January 2014, was supported by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) under the theme 'Count Me In'. The subsequent year, the overarching theme was 'Swachh Bharat', which was synchronous with the national mission by the same name. In 2016, the National Volunteering Week was held under the theme 'I For India', to establish the importance of individual volunteering. The intent was to engage Indians from all walks of life in celebrating, initiating and expanding the act of service for the common good. "I For India" resonated with all stakeholders and thus became the established theme for National Volunteering Week in the years to come.

NVW 2017 was different in that it took volunteering to the hearts of the hinterland and reached 1401 villages under 'Mera Gaon Swachh Gaon' campaign.

India@75 has been working to continuously scale up the impact of volunteering. In 2018, NVW had a cumulative outreach of 16.5 million people with 3,13,000 hours



of volunteering. In 2019, India@75 along with partners from across the country, used the NVW as a platform to bring together different stakeholders and catalyze important long-term partnerships between them. The week enabled important collaborations between corporates, non-profits and other stakeholders, who incorporated volunteering as an essential part of their operations.

Carrying forward the spirit of the previous editions, NVW 2020 sought to enable collaboration between the stakeholders crucial to the volunteering ecosystem. This is in line with the CII@125 agenda of engaging with the community.

National Volunteering Week 2020

National Volunteering Week has been gaining in strength every year and now taken the shape of a movement. Carrying forward the successes of the previous years, NVW 2020 saw stakeholders from different walks of life coming together to celebrate the spirit of volunteerism in different capacities. Apart from growing in scale, the week helped form long-term partnerships between corporates, NGOs, academic institutions and other stakeholders.

Continuing the theme of "I for India", NVW 2020 successfully conducted 352 activities across 56 locations across the country. These activities offered volunteers the opportunity to contribute to women empowerment, health and hygiene, climate action, sports and culture, education and skill development.

15,315 plus volunteers put in around 95,245 hours and reached out to 1,01,44,762 people. About 1,98,177 people benefitted from the effort. India@75 partnered with a total of 28 entities to make this possible. They included 11 corporates, 11 NGOs, three academic institutions, two VIOs and one organization belonging to the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) segment.

Alongside the activities conducted specifically during the week, the National Volunteering Grid (NVG), an online collaboration platform created by India@75 to institutionalize the process of volunteering, also served to up the ante. Nonprofits used the platform to list volunteering opportunities and connect with prospective candidates. India@75 ran extensive social media campaigns to spread awareness of both the activities listed on the portal as well as those being held only during the NVW. This helped increase the momentum and maximize the reach of volunteerism.

"The process of socializing the concept of India@75 and working with state level planners and a large cross section of society must now translate into a standing group of volunteers who will work full time - a India@75 Peace Corps - if you will. We need young people with passion, dedication and a willingness to devote a few years of their time to build a new India, the India@75."

Highlights of the week



HEALTH & HYGIENE



▲ With its name in Limca book of records for creating awareness about cleanliness and personal hygiene among underprivileged children, **Sahyog Care For You** conducted an awareness session on hand washing, sanitation and hygiene in a Government school at Palwal, Haryana. 664 people including students and teachers benefitted from the session.

▲ **Nirbhed Foundation** organized a Medical camp in Indrapuram, Ghaziabad with the help of volunteers. 270 students and 180 Adults were examined and provided medicines.

Corporate participation

NVW 2020 saw increased corporate participation. Employees actively engaged on different thematic areas like environment, education, health, hygiene and skill development. While volunteering brings personal satisfaction, a corporate culture that encourages one to work for the community, adds to the sense of pride that employees feel in their organization. It also gives them an organized approach to engage with the community and use their interests, skill-sets, and time to solve community challenges. The community benefits but so do corporates, because volunteering helps build a workforce that operates on the tenets of sense and sensibility.

NVW 2020 saw organizations like Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), PVR Nest, Western digital, Nayara Energy, Cognizant, Jaksons group, Schneider Electric Foundation, SBI Foundation, Skoda Auto Volkswagen India, Hero MotoCorp Ltd and Windlass biotech Pvt. Ltd. participate in a big way.

Some highlights are as below:

During the National Volunteering Week, TCS conducted volunteering activities on the theme of education, health and environment. It engaged with 7,712 volunteers and generated 60,000+ volunteering hours. Cognizant organised 140+ activities across 10 cities in the areas of



climate action, disability and health. For the first time an MSME, Excelize software Pvt. Ltd from Aurangabad joined the volunteering movement. These collaborations will encourage other corporates & MSMEs to follow suit and contribute to the culture of volunteering. 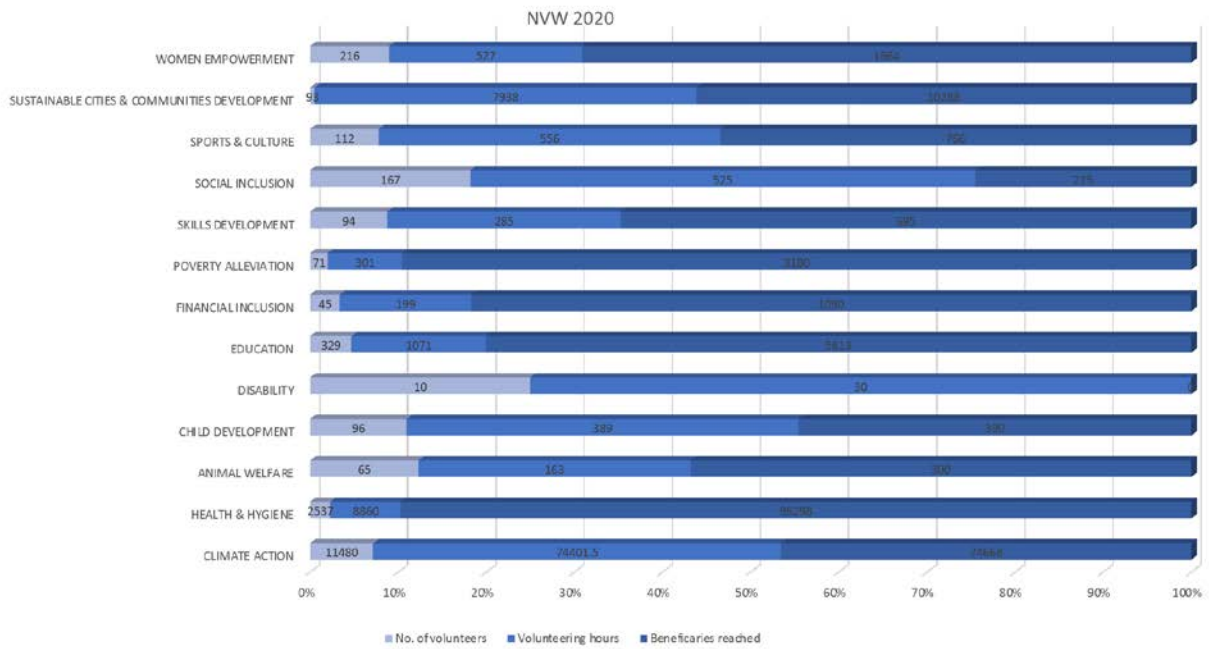
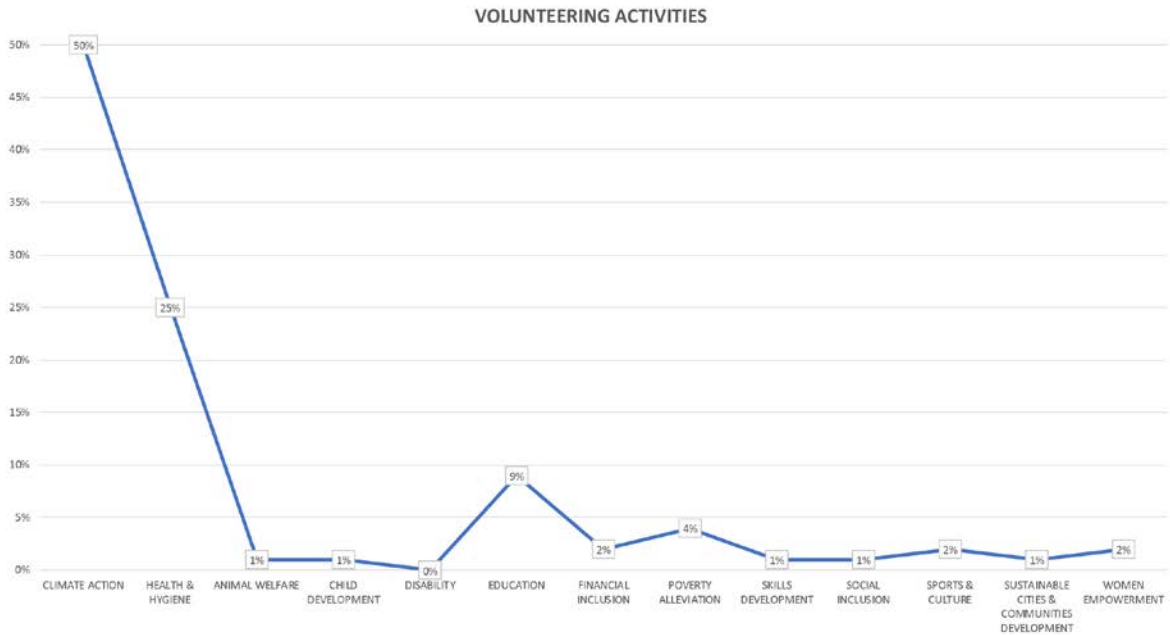

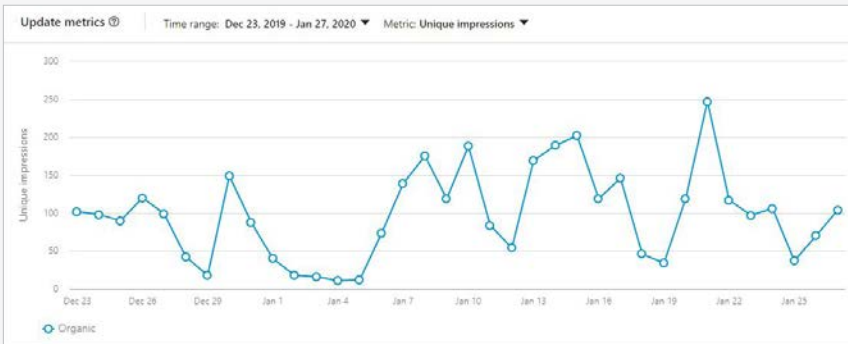

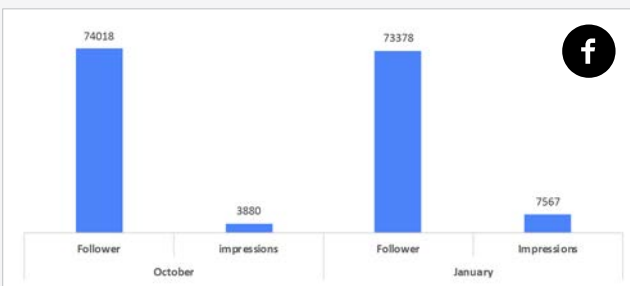
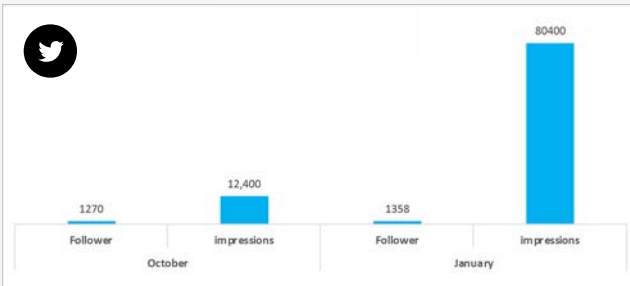
